

AYY: Benefits (1/3)

- An association in AYY's association register receives the same rights as an individual student union member, as well as services particularly aimed at associations.
- Rental of AYY's van and facilities rented on a one-time basis
- Opportunity to rent club or storage facilities
- Advance booking of facilities rented on a one-time basis for associations in the first list



AYY: Benefits (2/3)

- Operating grants for associations in the first list
- Opportunity to apply for project founding from <u>TTE-Fund</u>
- Association newsletter
- Association profile on AYY's website and the opportunity to add events to the calendar on the website

AYY: Benefits (3/3)

- IT and office services

AYY: Obligations

Yearly notice:

Each association in the register must **annually** submit the association notice in order to review that the association is still active and meets the requirements set by the Association Regulation.

Rule amendments:

If the association amends its rules, it must notify the organisation specialist immediately, who checks that the conditions set for the register membership are also met after the amendments.

AYY: Obligations

If the association no longer complies with the requirements of the Association Regulation, the board may remove the association from the entire register or transfer it to a lower list.

- >> The board may also remove the association from the register if the association fails to deliver the association notice in two consecutive years.
- >> All services will end

AYY: Obligations in the first list

- At least 60% and at least seven (7) of the association members entitled to vote must be members of AYY (does not apply to choirs or orchestras)
- Association rules must not limit the opportunity of the student union members to become association members entitled to vote: AYY's members may not be discriminated against.
- When the association is discontinued or suspended, its funds must be transferred to the student union or other organisation within the student union.




Printed material

- Posters
 - Price-efficiency rate not so good Cheap printing online (e.g. http://print24.com/fi-fi/)
- Flyers
- Table toppers
 Expensive, but may be very effective
- Badges for overalls
 NOTE! Order well in advance. At least 3-5 weeks.

Acts and regulations

Association act

Rules

 Read your association's rules – and make sure everyone else in your board does too!

Your association always has to follow it's own rules

Rule amedments

- I. Draft new rules (use for example AYY's Sample rules)
- 2. Contact <u>jarjestoasiat@ayy.fi</u>, and we'll check that the rules are fit according to AYY's association regulation. This check does not replace PRH's check.
- 3. Accepting of the rules at the meeting(s) of the association
- 4. Submitting the new rules to PRH
- 5. If PRH wants changes to the rules, you'll need to submit the corrected rules afterwards also to AYY
- 6. An amendment of rules enters into force once it is entered in the PRH's register.

Rights & responsibilities

Registered associations

A registered association

- Is a legal person
- Can acquire assets, apply for grants or get permission for fundraising
- Can be a party in an agreement e.g. bank account, rental agreement
- Single board members are not held responsible for association activities

Does not include criminal liability

Obligations & requirements

- A registered association is obliged to inform PRH about
 - Changes of persons entitled to sign for the association
 - Rule Amendments
 - Dissolution
- According to the Association Act every association has to have
 - A board and operations inspectors elected at a meeting of the association
 - Accounting
 - Meetings according to the rules
 - The right of members participate in and inspect activities



Equality of members

- Associations can take members according to their rules, but never without the consent of the person in question. This applies also the other way around: the association doesn't have to accept all applicants
- All members have to be treated equally in every case unless the rules have different member categories. No member can be treated indifferently within a member category

Accounting

- One of the most important responsibilities of the board
 Usually delegated to the treasurer, but the whole board is responsible
 of the finances
- Has to be done according to the accounting period mentioned in the rules
- Financial statements must be done and approved by the association's meeting during the four months after accounting period has ended

Operations inspection

Operations inspection is mandatory

For the inspector the board has to submit all meeting minutes, bank balance and transactions, receipts, accounting, financial statements and action report

The operations inspector can be a layman, but cannot be disqualified. "The operations inspector shall possess financial and legal knowledge to a degree to be deemed necessary in view of the association's operations in order to carry out the operations inspection task." (Assoc. Act 38)



Fundraising

An association can

- collect a membership fee according to its rules
- conduct small item lotteries
- sell products as long as it's not taken as a source of livelyhood

There are differences between products and also cash inflow If the action is considered as something that someone other lives from, it is usually almost immediately considered as income taxable revenue



GDPR - Data Safety in Associations

- General Data Protection Regulation
- EU regulation, defines how personal data of EU citizens should be handled
- Sanctions from misuse can scale to exorbitant sums of money

- Association notice in March: detailed info and exact dates will be published in the association newsletter during February. Association grant application at the same time.
- Updated profile on ayy.fi: http://ayy.fi/en/associations/associationslist/
- If the association amends its rules, it must notify the organizational affairs specialist immediately, who checks that the conditions set for the register membership are still met after the amendments.
